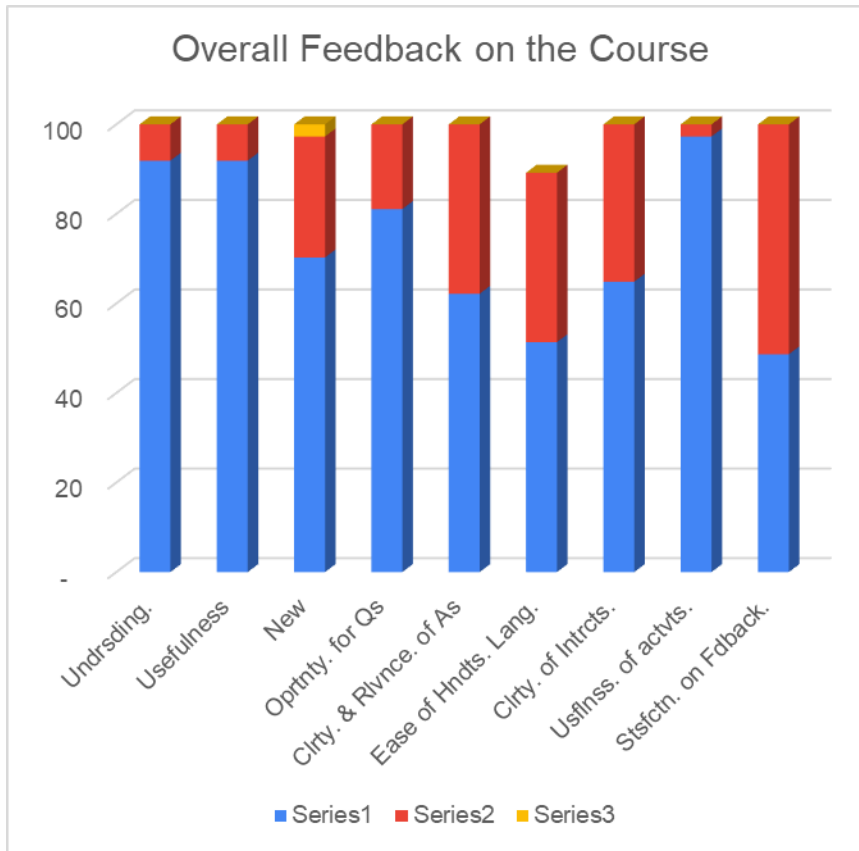
The feedback was taken on 10 simple questions, on scale 1 to 3. General idea behind the scale was 1 for minimum of quality or least appropriate, expressed in appropriate terms for the aspect of the course to which the questions were related; similarly 2 for satisfactory and 3 for highest. (All the questions are also given in the original below, with detailed feedback).

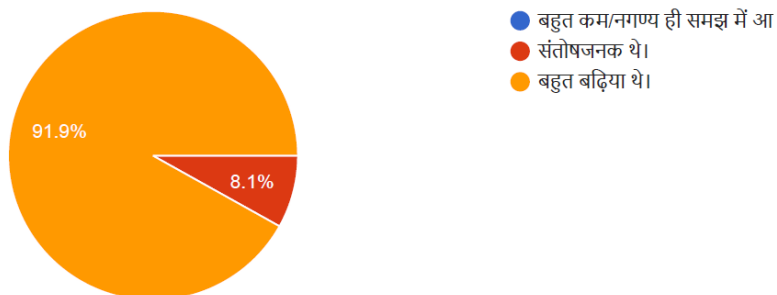
A graphic representation of the above data in the above table

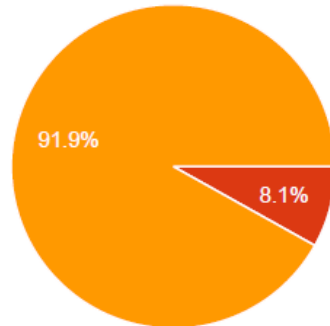

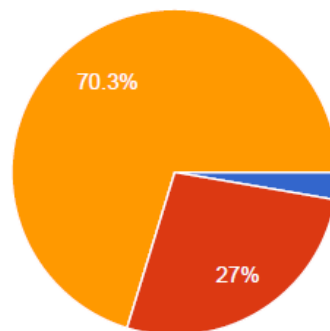

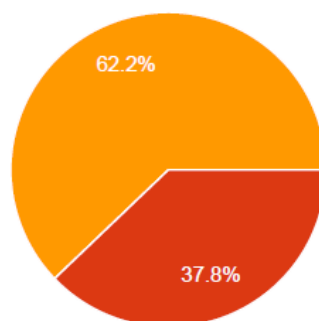

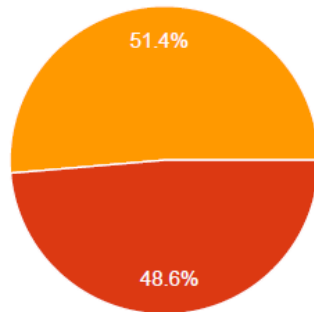

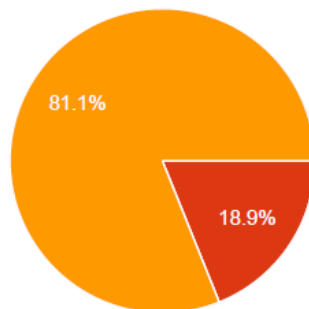

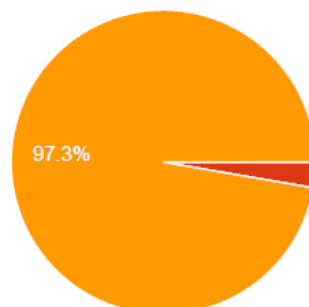

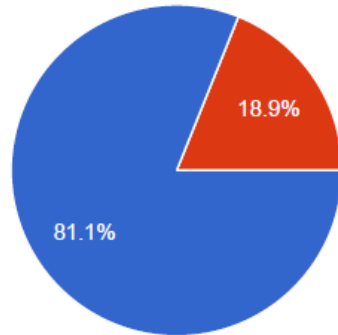

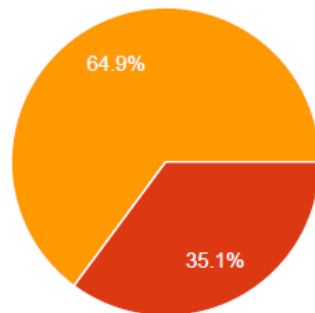

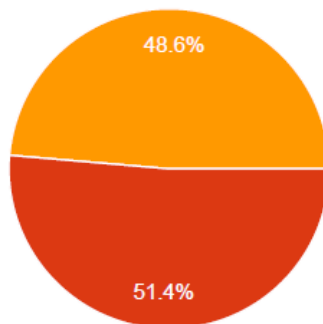
